The CFPSS operates at a local, regional and national level, providing fellowship and opportunities to share and study at residential and one-day conferences, and at local group and branch meetings. It also publishes two journals, *The Christian Parapsychologist* and *The Quarterly Review*, sent free to all members.

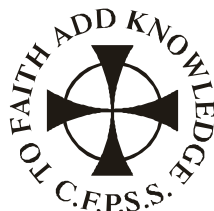
Membership

There are two categories of membership: full and associate. Those eligible for **full membership** must be members of a Christian church and/or must acknowledge Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour of the world. A reference is required from either a minister of a Christian church or a full member of the Fellowship. **Associate membership** is open to all without the need for reference, but such members are not eligible to hold office or to vote.

Library and Study Material

There is a library at Head Office for the use of all members, operated on a postal basis, with outward postage paid by the Fellowship. A full catalogue is available, price £3.

Books, booklets, audio and video tapes are available for borrowing or purchase, and a series of study notes on a variety of subjects has been prepared for individual or group use. Full details are available from the General Secretary (address overleaf).
